SRNS Receives Award of Excellence from United Way of the CSRA **Thousands of SRNS employees work together year-round to financially help those in need throughout the Central Savannah River Area**

AIKEN, S.C. – (March 13, 2013) Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, LLC (SRNS) was recently presented the top honor for a corporation from the United Way of the CSRA, the Award of Excellence, received for contributing the largest donation during their 2012 campaign.

In total, during the 2012 campaign, SRNS employees raised more than \$1.17 million to benefit United Way agencies found throughout the greater Aiken-Augusta area of which, \$358,000 was donated to the United Way of the CSRA. SRNS employees also leveraged a matching plan offered by one of their parent companies, Fluor Federal Services, adding another \$64,000 to the total contribution. After receiving an additional check from SRNS corporate headquarters personnel for \$12,000, the grand total came close to half a million dollars – \$434,000.

& CEO, United Way of the CSRA. “Whether in good times or bad, they give with their hearts to help so many people in need. We are truly touched.”

“SRNS makes supporting United Way a year round focus. Annually they create their own video featuring several United Way groups, send out multiple newsletters, hold countless bake sales, cookouts, and special activities to raise money through employee contributions,” said Gold.

Gold also noted that SRNS generously made a separate corporate donation of \$200,000 to the region’s various United Way organizations this past year.

According to 2012 SRNS Employee United Way Campaign Chair Tammy Rimes, SRNS employees are already planning for next year’s campaign. “We just selected the chairperson for 2013,” said Rimes. “We’re already off and running.”
