SRNS Donates \$10,000 for 100th Habitat for Humanity House in Aiken County

AIKEN, S.C. – August 27, 2015 – Over the years, 99 Habitat for Humanity houses have been built in Aiken County for deserving families. Recently, Jim Barry, Savannah River Nuclear Solutions Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, presented Richard Church, Executive Director, Aiken County Habitat for Humanity, and Aaron Washington, Board President, Aiken County Habitat for Humanity, \$10,000 for the 100th house.
